

How to play Human Bingo

- 1. Give each child a Bingo card.
- 2. Explain that they have 30 minutes to mingle and find people who match the traits on the card. Each box must have a different person.
- 3. They must put the person's name in the corresponding box or have the person sign the appropriate square.
- 4. The first person to fill five boxes across or down yells "Bingo!" and the game is over.
- 5. The game could continue until someone has completed all the boxes and shouts "Full House".

There are a range of Bingo cards - select one that fits your class best. It is recommended that the adults in the classroom join in too.
