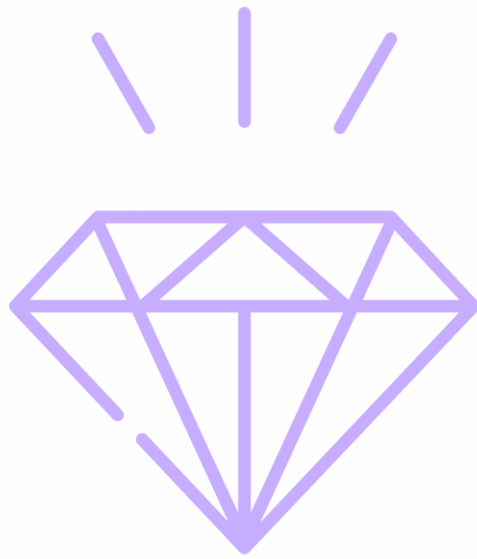

ENGLISH

GPS

There are separate programmes for Spelling, Grammar & Punctuation. For each National Curriculum objective there is an editable teaching PowerPoint which includes whole class, group and individual activities. These PowerPoints are adaptable and may be used over more than 1 session. A range of activities suitable for each objective is provided with paper versions.

In addition, to support Spelling, we have created a multi-sensory bank of adaptable activities suitable for use across the key stage. This bank is very popular as a resource for intervention groups but is widely used for whole class teaching too.

GPS Let's talk is a series of discussion prompts designed to probe pupil's understanding of the technicalities of key aspects of GPS. Quizzes and starter activities are also available and aligned to our Spelling, Grammar & Punctuation Schemes of work. These are great for retrieval practice.

Assessment packs for the Spelling, Grammar & Punctuation Programme are also available. These include: Teacher Guidance; Mark Schemes; Spreadsheet for analysis and Pupil tests.

READING

Reading Guides - are suitable for whole class guided reading; group guided reading or for units of work. These fully-resourced chapter by chapter guides include: Discussion Questions; Reading Skills activities; GPS links; Vocabulary work; Writing opportunities and suggestions for foundation subjects. Within Reading activities there is always a Reading Comprehension, a Summary and a time line to track key plot points in the story. Other Reading activities may include:

- Character Analysis
- Emotion Graphs
- Drama
- Comparisons
- Explanations
- Prediction

READING [continued]

Reading Skills - a series of teaching PowerPoints to develop key skills which include:

- text retrieval
- inference
- comparison
- skimming and scanning
- summarising

Activities to support each of these skills are also available. A fantastic resource to build comprehension skills and techniques.

Reading Challenges - each challenge comprises a range of tasks which vary in number and genre. The challenges include nonfiction and poetry as well as fiction. A great way to encourage readers of all abilities.

Our Reading Challenges include:

- Reading Trios - each Trio has 3 challenges around a theme EG Spooky Stories; Sporting Stars; One Author Three Books
- Reading Quads - each Quad has 4 challenges linked to a topic EG Frozen Kingdoms; Road Trip UK
- Mini Reading Challenges - each Mini has 5 challenges with a theme EG Fantasy Fantastic; Top Secret; Have a Giggle
- Year group reading challenges - designed to last for a school year these challenges encourage children to read a wide range of authors; genre and text types.

Certificates are available for each Challenge to recognise a child's achievements.

In addition, comprehensive lists of books for each year group are available. These lists include: fiction genres; nonfiction and poetry suitable for the year group.

WRITING

Narrative

Writing Workshops focus on specific areas of narrative writing and include:

- setting description;
- dialogue;
- story openings and openings;
- planning and writing action scenes
- character-building.

The PowerPoints have been designed to be adapted to suit the needs of your class and used over several sessions. Drama is used to allow children to experience and explore before they put pen to paper. WAGOLLS are provided too.

Nonfiction

Units are available for Discussion; Instructions; Recount; Explanation; Persuasion and Report.

Each unit contains a Teacher Guidance document which supports teachers planning a unit of work using our resources. Only the class teacher knows the needs of their class, with this in mind, we have prepared a wide range of resources for each unit for teachers to choose to adapt and use with their class. There are several editable PowerPoints for each unit which include text features; modelled writing and specific examples of the different types of writing. For example: Recounts has PowerPoints for Autobiography; Diary amongst others.

In addition, there is a range of activities to support teaching the relevant features for each text type. WAGOLLS are integrated into PowerPoints. Planners and Steps to Success are available for each text type.

The Repair Shop - a great framework for children to learn how to edit their own work. Fully resourced with mats and prompts to support children with this necessary but tricky skill. Suitable for fiction and nonfiction writing.

MATHS

ARITHMETIC

Four in Four is a resource designed to promote fluency. Children complete 4 calculations in 4 minutes. Sets are available for each year group's NC objectives and contain 10 sheets per set with answers provided. Sets focus on a single operation or two operations or all four operations.

Missing Digits is a resource designed to assess the children's understanding of formal written calculation. Sets are available for each year group's NC objectives.

Both of these resources are widely used in daily Maths meetings, as starter activities or as the focus for a lesson.

LET'S TALK

For each year group's area of Maths, these discussion prompts focus on common misconceptions. Three children share their thoughts about a concept -

who is correct and why are the others incorrect? Many teachers use these to assess conceptual understanding at the start of a unit but they can be used during and towards the end of a unit. Great for whole class or small group work.

MENTAL MATHS PROGRAMME

Our Mental Maths Programme ensures that key skills are taught in line with the National Curriculum and progression across the year groups. The Programme, for each year group, includes:

- an overview which maps the objectives week by week for each term
- assessment packs for each term
- a programme for each term detailing for each objective relevant activities
- various resources to rehearse key skills EG Pathfinders; Numbercross
- weekly Mental Maths tests.

MATHS [continued]

QUIZZES

A range of quizzes are available for each area of Maths - great for retrieval practice or to assess knowledge.

SOMETIMES, ALWAYS, NEVER

Banks of Sometimes, Always, Never statements are available for each area of Maths for each year group. A great way to assess depth of understanding and identify misconceptions. Develops use of mathematical language and explanation skills.

SPOT THE MISTAKE

Can your class spot the deliberate errors? Can they explain the error? Can they correct the error? Find out with these sets created to assess depth of understanding and identify misconceptions.

TIMES TABLES

A range of resources are available which include; practice sheets; multiplication grids and games. All specific to year group objectives. A Times Table Programme is available for Years 3 and 4.

VOCABULARY

Vocabulary packs for display and quizzes are available.

MORNING WORK

Each month we upload Morning Work for each year group. Every day there are different open-ended GPS and Maths activities. All are pre-dated so all you have to do is display it!

SCIENCE

Vocabulary packs and Working Scientifically sentence stems are available.

TOPIC OVERVIEWS

What's a Topic Overview?

A Topic Overview is a collection of ideas and suggestions to start your topic planning. We have over 80 Topic Overviews which cover the English National Curriculum and more.

Each overview has a subject focus - English; History; Geography or Science with links to all the core and foundation subjects too. Included in each overview are:

- book suggestions;
- visit locations;
- links to useful websites
- hooks to launch your topic.
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In your download you also get Questions to Investigate which are banks of enquiry-based questions that you can select from to plan each session. A vocabulary pack is also included.

Y6 SATs

To support Y6 teachers preparing for SATs we have the following specific resources:

- **GPS 5 a day** - each PowerPoint contains 5 questions specific to a particular objective. The questions are based on questions in test papers from previous years.
- **Maths 5 a Day** - each PowerPoint contains 5 questions specific to a particular domain. The questions are based on questions in test papers from previous years.
- **SATs papers Spot the Mistake** - Test papers from previous years completed with deliberate errors - can the children find and correct the mistakes? The mistakes are similar to those commonly made by children in test papers.
- **Morning Work** - 15 weeks of daily activities to use in the run up to SATs. Each day of the week has Maths and GPS questions modelled on questions from prior years 'test papers'. Each day has a short text with comprehension questions; the texts cover fiction, nonfiction and poetry. Y6 Morning Work is a great way to assess knowledge and skills while revising areas taught earlier in KS2.
